If the Tribes request SPIPA have a 7.01 meeting, SPIPA would be willing to meet.</p> <p>An email was sent to Debra Gibson/SPIPA County Services Director on 3/18/19 and she replied confirming this plan.</p> <p>Note: The Division of Child Support has had several meetings with SPIPA in the past year to review, refine and improve processes and routinely did outreach from their office.
