

Clarifying Information - [WAC 388-460-0010](#)

1. When a facility acts as an authorized representative for persons in a group home or chemical dependency treatment facility, one person from the facility usually acts on behalf of all the clients in that facility or group home.
- ~~2.~~ The Department of Agriculture, Food and Nutrition Services (FNS) regulates the facilities in their use of client's Basic Food benefits. ~~The following expectations are listed for information only.~~
- ~~2.~~ Upon leaving a group home or treatment facility, a Basic Food client is entitled to a prorated amount of their Basic Food allotment based on the number of days left in the month. ~~at least~~

~~one half of the Basic Food benefits if the client leaves before the 16th of the month and part of the benefits have already been spent on behalf of the client.~~
