Clarifying Information - WAC 388-444-0075

~~For a Basic Food applicant, the disqualification lasts at least until 60 days after the date the job quit occurred. This means that the first quit disqualification may be longer than one month. The Δ disqualification cannot be less than the one month appropriate penalty period~~ unless the client becomes exempt from work registration as described in WAC 388-444-0075 (5).

The penalties for quitting a job or reducing hours are:

1st time – one month;

2nd time – three months

3 or more times – six months

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NOTE:

Do not delay benefits to an otherwise eligible person beyond the normal processing time while ~~the outcome of determining good cause is pending-awaiting a good cause determination.~~
