DSHS amends the RFQQ #1934-727 procurement document to include:

Bidder's Questions and Answers
RFQQ 1934-727

Question #1: The project scope on page 4 specifies 10-15 days of content in 2-5 day sessions. This implies at least two sessions per cohort. Page 5 specifies 9 cohorts; 7 in specified field offices and 2 make up sessions. This would imply 18 training sessions total in order to impart 10-15 days of content to 9 cohorts.

On page 7, the Funding bullet specifies 9 training sessions for the two year period. These numbers are inconsistent. Can you clarify?

A: The 10-15 days in 2-5 day period was given as a **guide** to try and align the bidders to us wanting a multiday event. DSHS views meetings or a series of meetings as a body for the transaction of business or period devoted to a particular activity. This term was **not** used to narrow the scope of days for the potential bidders. A session could have multiple days all continuing from another.

Question #2: We are assuming that all 180 DVR employees would be provided with 10-15 days of training in 2-5 day sessions, in groups of 25. Is that correct?

A: Yes, the 10-15 days in 2-5 day periods was given as a **guide** to try and align the bidders to us wanting a multiday training event.

All other terms and conditions in this Solicitation remain the same.
